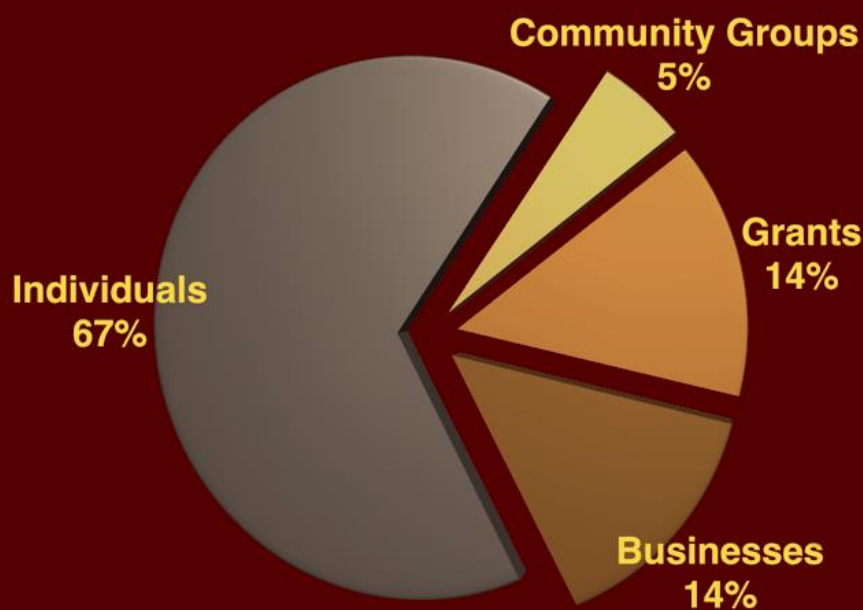

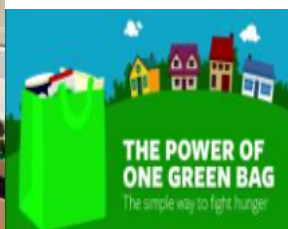

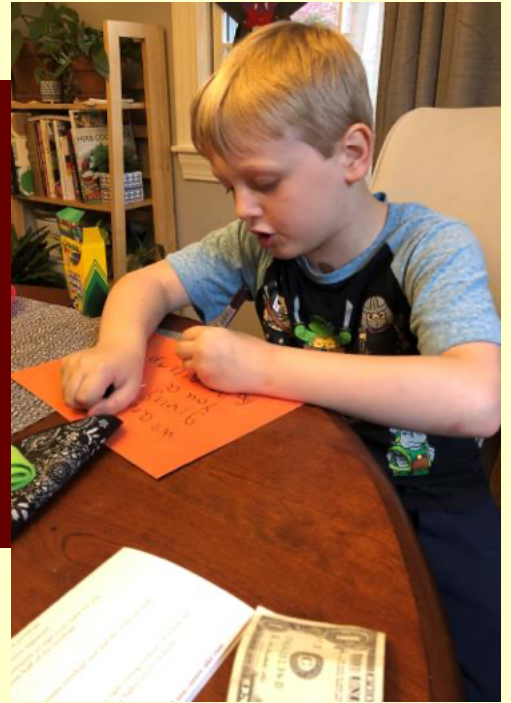
BRIANNA, with an assist from big brother **RYAN**, made bracelets and necklaces, sold them and donated the profits to the Pantry!

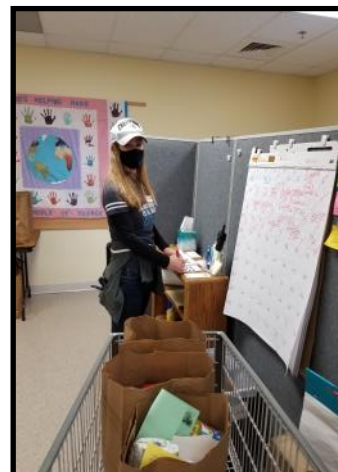
